**Standard Operating Procedure for Collection of Hajj applications along with Hajj dues from Overseas Pakistanis during Hajj 2020**

- (i) The Overseas Pakistani applying for Hajj under said quota must provide copy of NICOP/PASSPORT/VISA as documentary proof to the designated banks. The concerned bank receiving the application form from/on his/her behalf may ensure receipt of copy of NICOP/PASSPORT/VISA.
- (ii) Hajj application form along with Hajj dues may be submitted by his/her blood relative on his/her behalf in Pakistan on authorization from the Overseas Pakistanis.
- (i) The Overseas Pakistani or his/her nominee will sign Hajj application form. They shall complete Biometric and medical certification on their return from abroad. They must submit their Machine Readable Pakistani Passports in the respective banks (valid up to 1<sup>st</sup> February, 2021) at least 25 days before their flight.
- (ii) In case number of Hajj applications from Overseas Pakistanis is less than the prescribed quota of 1000 seats by closing date, the remaining seats will be shifted to General Ballot.
- (iii) In case Hajj applications exceed from prescribed quota, they will be selected through ballot.
- (iv) In case any successful Overseas Pakistani did not proceed for Hajj due to any reason, no substitution shall be allowed in such cases.
